RAIN BARRELS

\$35+ REBATES (limit 2)

SOIL MOISTURE SENSOR SYSTEM

ROTATING SPRINKLER NOZZLES

for nozzles that apply water slowly and uniformly to prevent over-watering and encourage healthy plant growth. Participants must buy at least 30 nozzles from the list of qualified products.

FLOW MONITORING/LEAK DETECTION DEVICES

REBATES START AT \$100 FOR QUALIFYING MODELS

Flow monitoring/leak detection devices monitor your home's water use and can help detect leaks.
